





## The Four C's



### 1. Clean

Clean band using **70% alcohol** spray and wipe down with a clean lint-free cloth or paper tower every time the band is removed.



## 2. Cool

Band may cause baby to perspire. Dress baby in cooler clothing. We suggest one layer less of clothing, removing socks and/or footwear and having good air circulation (fan) in sleeping areas.



## 3. Comfortable

If a pink broad area occurs and goes away in **30-60 minutes**, continue use. If deep redness occurs that does not clear in 30-60 minutes, allow redness to clear. Place band and see if redness comes back. *If so, contact the clinician*.



## 4. Comply

Follow the band wearing schedule meticulously.

### Remove band if:

- Cleaning the band
- Neck exercises (for Torticollis)
- Baby has fever / flu
- Bathing / swimming
- Rash develops. If rash persists and comes back after one day, contact the clinician.

# **Band Care**

- Only use unscented 70% rubbing alcohol on inside of band.
- Clean inner plastic/foam parts immediately upon removal.
- Wipe down band with clean, lint-free dry cloth.
- · Check if strap is still secured.
- Do not use soaps or household cleaners on band.
- Do not use lotions / wipes on head or band.
- Do not shave baby's head before band use.
- Do not leave the band in very hot environment such as a car or windowsill.
- Do not leave the band around pets.
- **Do not** discontinue use of band during treatment (unless rash, fever or flu occurs).
- Do not continue to use band after treatment.

Maintenance and adjustments must be performed by clinicians or clinics certified by HeadStart Medical only.

Use: To be worn by child to improve symmetrical head shape.

Materials: Frame - PolyLactic Acid, Strap - Thermoplastic Polyurethane,

Liner - Orthopeadic grade foam.

Directions: To be worn by child according to the schedule assigned by the attending **ROKband** certified clinician. Cranial Band is to be removed at least once a day to clean and dry. Band should be placed on the head so that the trimline is above the eyebrows and ears while maintaining good contact with the forehead.

Maintenance: Maintenance and adjustments must be performed by clinicians or clinics certified by HeadStart medical.
